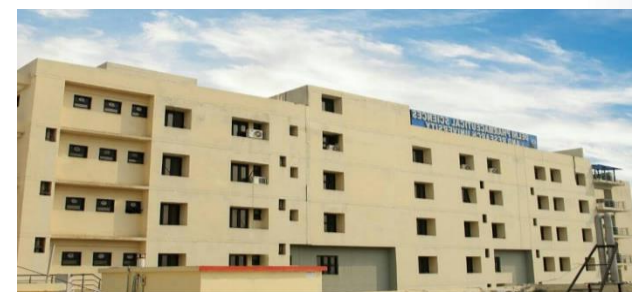

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Delhi Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research University (DPSRU) is the first Pharmacy University of India, established by the Act 7 of 2008 of state Legislature of Govt of NCT of Delhi and has been functioning from August 2015.

DPSRU offers professional Masters Programmes in **Hospital Management, Public Health and Pharmaceutical Management** apart from its flagship courses at Diploma, UG, PG and Doctoral levels (in various specializations of Pharmaceutical and Allied Sciences) and B.Sc (Sports Pharmacy) and BPT (Bachelors in Physiotherapy). Although DPSRU is just three years old, it has a strong legacy of 53 years in the form of College of Pharmacy (1964), institute popularly known as DIPSAR with various centers of excellence including Ocular Pharmacology Lab., Pharmacovigilance Centre, Drugs and Poison Information Centre and Centre for Clinical Trials (BA/BE studies). The University is equipped with over 50 labs.

Master of Hospital Management and Master of Public Health programs at DPSRU started in the year 2016 with an intake of 10 students in each. The first batches passed in 2018 and the students are successfully placed in organizations like BLK Memorial Hospital, Mamata Foundation, UNESCO, WNS Global Services and NHI among others.

During the past three years DPSRU along with its constituent college DIPSAR has organized one international conference, several workshops on topics like IPR, incubation and innovation, physiotherapy symposium, many guest lectures and expert talks by eminent speakers from Canada, Germany, Australia etc. The university has entered into MoU with many renowned organizations like Dabur Foundation, IPC, IREDA and ICMER and a few international universities. The university has also started "Incubation Centre" to roll out startups.
