The Faculty and students of SAHSM participated in the 19thHealth Summit 2022, organized by The Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), in New Delhi on 29.11.2022. The theme of this year's summit was –The Health Imperative - Accessibility, Affordability, Accountability, Adaption and Awareness. The event was attended by the students of MHA and MPH program along with the faculty members – Dr. Puneeta Ajmera. Dr. Sheetal Yadav and Dr. Sheetal Kalra.

The inaugural session had eminent personalities from Hospital and Healthcare Industry as panelists and moderators, including Ms. Shobana Kamineni (Executive Vice Chairperson of Apollo Hospitals), Dr. Naresh Trehan (Chairman and Managing Director – Medanta-The Medicity), Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya (Minister of Health & Family Welfare and Chemical & Fertilizers). Plenary Session 1 was on the Business of Health – Moving towards trust-based care and bridging the Health- wealth gaps. Plenary Session 2 was on 'Health is Not Alone' – Connecting the dots of systematic health literacy, affordability, Universal coverage and value-based pricing. The resource persons included Dr. Shubnum Singh (Principal Advisor - Health Policy Confederation of Indian Industry), Dr. Sudha Chandrashekar (Executive Director National Health Authority), Dr. Santosh Mathew (Country Lead Public Policy and Finance Gates Foundation), Mr. Krishnan Ramachandran (CEO and Managing Director Niva Bupa Health Insurance) & Mr. Dilip Jose (Managing Director and CEO, Manipal Health Enterprises Pvt. Ltd). The Plenary Sessions in the second half focussed on Disruption in Pharma and Med-tech Sector – Moving up the value chain, Decoding Digital Transformation in Healthcare, Globalization of Indian Healthcare and Opportunities & Barriers for India to lead the way towards integrative care. Experts from Hospital Industry, Mr. Sai Prasad (Executive Director, Bharat Biotech), Mr. Himanshu (Managing Director, Polymed), Dr. Alexander Kuruvilla (Chief Healthcare Strategy Officer, Practo), & Mr. Pankaj Sahni (CEO, Medanta-The Medicity), talked about the future of health. Other resource persons included were Dr. Renu Swarup, Former Secretary Dept. of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Mr. Naveen Kumar (Special Secretary, Health, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh), Mr. Darpan Jain (Joint Secretary, Ministry of Commerce and Industry), The program concluded that with India heading towards its year of G20 presidency, Health care can take center stage. Health care is not just an

industry but a collaborative, coordinated & conducive platform for all stakeholders to come together to achieve the “Continuum of Care” as intended goal of India. Our students also had the opportunity to interact with all these eminent speakers.

The vaccination camp was inaugurated by Prof Ramesh K Goyal, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor DPSRU and around 250 people got benefitted with this vaccination camp. 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Visit to GB Pant by BMLT and DMLT students

19 to 20 September 2022

School in collaboration with Govind Ballabh Pant (G. B. Pant) Institute of PGER, organized 2 day laboratory visit on 19 -20 September 2022 to medical laboratory of G.B.Pant Hospital, New Delhi. A total of 88 BMLT and DMLT students of second semester along with faculty members visited different departments such as Microbiology, Biochemistry, Pathology laboratories and Blood bank of the hospital to get an exposure of various equipment's and different technologies used in the laboratories.

The laboratory visit started with the warm welcome and opening remarks by Dr.Jaseela Majeed to students. After that the students were divided into groups supervised by faculty incharge and were sent to different laboratories on rotation basis.

In Biochemistry laboratory, an introduction to chemiluminescence analyzer was given by the Dr. Bhawana Mahajan, Associate Professor (Biochemistry), G.B.Pant Hospital. Later, the senior technician of the laboratory demonstrated the chemiluminescence immunoassay to test the hormones, vitamins, cardiac disease biomarkers. It is based on the enzyme labeled antibodies and antigens to detect the small biological molecules required.

In Microbiology Laboratory, a general introduction to bacterial culture, antibiotic sensitivity testing was given by the senior technicians. Demonstration of Bactec bottle, red topped plain container, urine microscopy by using cled media, BACTEC MGIT 960 instrument fully automated system that exploits the fluorescence of an oxygen sensor to detect growth of Mycobacterium, TB testing room was shown to students.

In Pathology Laboratory, brief introduction of various instruments used for performing tissue biopsy was shown to students by Mrs. Deepa, Senior Technician, Pathology department. The techniques used for tissue fixation, dehydration, embedding, sectioning, staining was explained to students in brief.

In Blood Bank, general introduction for blood donation and requirements for donating blood was given by Mrs. Pankaj, Senior Technical Officer, Blood Bank. The demonstration of various instruments used in blood collection by healthy donor, the separation of plasma and cellular components of blood from donated blood, storage of different components was given by technicians.

The laboratory visit was jointly organized by Dr Swapan Gupta, Registrar Academic Cell of GB Pant Institute of Post Graduate Education and Research and Dr.Jaseela Majeed, Head, SAHSM, DPSRU which provided opportunities to students to understand the clinical practices. The program was well coordinated by faculty members, Dr .Ramsha Iqbal; Dr. Einstein Charles, Dr. Subodh Kumar, Dr, S.Sivakalai and Ms.SivaniDutt (Hospital Liaisoning officer). The 2 day laboratory visit was a great experience and a wonderful opportunity for the students to enhance their practical knowledge and skills. Thanks to Dr.Jaseela Majeed, for providing such opportunities to students and always motivating them to attend them well.

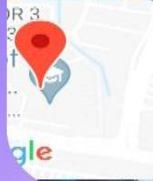

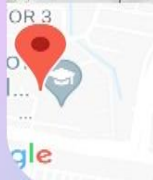
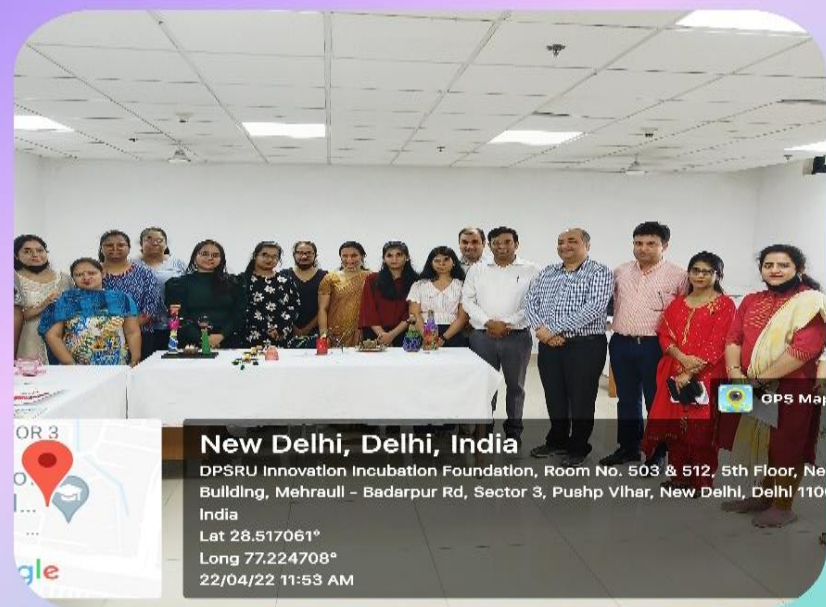

**Study on Dental Fluorosis among School Children by MPH Students
24.02.2022**

DPSRU has signed MoU with National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) on 24.02.2022. To keep the collaborations active, Dr. Rubina Parveen, PG student of Masters in Public Health (MPH) has done dissertation in collaboration with NCDC under the guidance of Dr. Meera Dhuria (Joint Director and HOD Non-Communicable Diseases, Biochemistry & toxicology, NCDC) and Dr. Jaseela Majeed (Head, SAHSM).

Dr. Rubina Parveen worked on “Prevalence of Dental Fluorosis among children of selected primary schools in Delhi”. 5 SDMC primary schools viz, “SDMC PS Kharkari Jatmal, SDMC PS khairacoed-1, SDMC PC KairaCoEd-2, SDMC PS New Roshanpura- Girls and SDMC PS New Roshanpura- Boys of Najafgargh area were high prevalence of dental fluorosis is reported have been selected for the study.

The work plan of the study was to select the area with highest 5-year average higher limit of ground water Fluoride concentration and areas with highest 5-year average lower limit of ground water Fluoride concentration as per reports of Central Ground Water Board followed by random selection of the schools from selected area and preparation of list of children aged 6-11 years (standard III - V) have done.

The data collection was done by distribution of survey questionnaire and filling up of desired information pertaining to various socio-epidemiological factors and recording of Medical history was done by Dr. Rubina Parveen along with the students of BBA in Community Health care, SAHSM on prior permission from school authorities.

Followed by dental examination to detect Dental Fluorosis in accordance with Dean's Fluorosis index by Dr. Rubina Parveen along with Dentist Vipin Khurana during which suspected cases of dental fluorosis have been ruled out. After that urine sample of the suspected have collected and send for test for urinary fluoride concentration. The vials were provided to the students and were instructed to fill them with drinking water and cooking water and the samples were sent to biochemistry laboratory of NCDC for tesing. On Dental Screening of 420 students, 82 have reported some degree of Dental Fluorosis making the prevalence to be 19.5%. where as the fluoride concentration of water sample and urine sample are awaited. It is expected to be an impactful study among school children in areas of suspected fluorosis.

National Deworming Day**

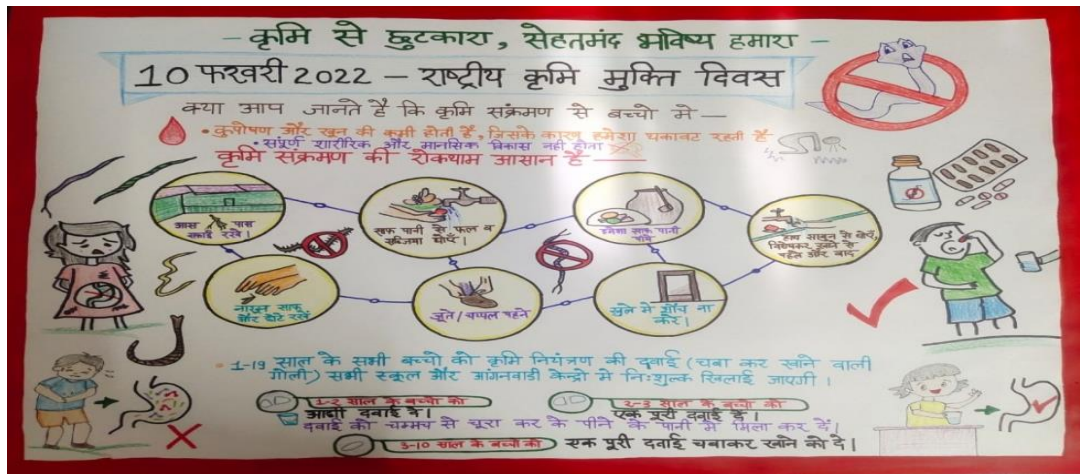
