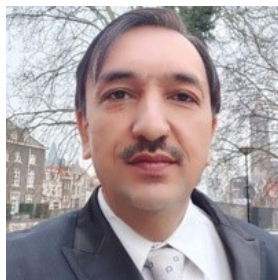

2. How can the B.Pharm (Ayurveda) course be strengthened to further improve research opportunities and employment prospects in both academia and industry?
3. Scope and framework for regulatory and registration procedures for B.Pharm (Ayurveda) students
