Frequently Asked Questions related to Online Examination-2020

- Q1. How the Online Exam. will be conducted?
- Ans. Online exam. will be conducted online with a compatible and secured browser on laptop/Computer/ Android Mobile.
- Q.2. How much Internet data is required to complete the online examination?
- Ans. 500 MB data is required to complete the exam but to the safer side, 1 GB data is preferable.
- Q.3. Which browser is suitable for the Online Exam?
- Ans. The Latest updated version of Chrome browser.
- Q.4. What should I do if my examination interrupted due to some technical issue?
- Ans. Students can take help from the technical person/supporting staff. Their Phone no or WhatsApp group no. will be shared well in time before the online Exam.
- Q.5. If exam stops due to internet problem or electricity issue then exam will start again or not?
- Ans. Yes, it will restart after 2 minutes. Don't be panic if your exam gets disconnected your response will be saved in the system and the exam will restart again from the specific question and for the remaining time where it stopped. System will allow candidate to login after two minutes only.
- Q.6. Can the student open another tab/screen other than the examination screen during the Online Exam?
- Ans. No, it is not permissible. However, if it happens by mistake then the system will permit three times.
- Q.7. If the student is sharing the room with the other family members, from where he is appearing in the Online Exam, then what is permissible?
- Ans. Any kind of help in answering the question is not permissible.
- Q.8. What will be the pattern of the question paper in Online Exam?
- Ans. It will contain objective and subjective questions in the ratio of approx. 50:50. For example- if your paper is of **75 marks** then Objective questions will be of **35 marks** and

Subjective questions will be of **40** marks; If maximum marks are **80** then Objective questions will be of **40 marks** and subjective questions will be of **40 marks**; If maximum marks are **60** then objective questions will be of **30 marks** and Subjective questions will be of **30 marks**.

- Q.9. Is the student can chat or take help from the Proctor during the Online Exam?
- Ans. Yes, Student can chat with the Proctor/invigilator through the same window during Online Exam.
- Q.10. At what time a student can log in for the Online Exam?
- Ans. Student can log-in 30 minutes before the start of the Online Exam.
- Q.11. What will be the authentic source of information related to Online Exam?
- Ans. Student can get latest and authentic information in the Examination section of university website. i.e. **dpsru.edu.in**
- Q.12. Is the mock drill will be conducted before the Online Exam?
- Ans. Yes, Mock drill will be conducted before the Online Exam.
- Q.13. If the student is not having university ID card then which another document can be used for uploading during approval from the Proctor.
- Ans. The university ID card is preferable. However, students can use Aadhaar card, Voter card, and Driving Licence as Proof of their Identity.
- Q.14. What will be the mode of answering and submission of answers for the subjective Questions?
- Ans. Students can write answers on the paper and then scanned images can be uploaded through the link which will come on the online exam screen and the linked e-mail just after the Exam submission.
- Q.15.Is there any provision of technical and permissible support for the student during the Online Exam?
- Ans. Yes, technical and permissible support will be provided by the technical team and Proctor respectively.
- Q.16. How much time will be given for reading and understanding the question Paper?
- Ans. Initial 10 minutes will be given for reading and understanding the question paper.

Q.17. How much time will be given for uploading the subjective answers?

Ans. 30 Minutes will be given for uploading after the submission of the Online Exam.

Q.18. How much time will be given to answer the objective and subjective questions in the

Online Exam.

Ans. 120 minutes will be given to answer the objective and subjective questions.

Q.19. Is there any possibility that students can use both the mode to appear in the final exam?

Ans. No, a student can opt either online or offline mode to appear in the final exams.

Q.20. What will be the option for the student if he/she would fail in any of the subjects during

Online Exam?

Ans. University cannot guarantee the announcement of results before the start of the offline

examinations. The candidate will be allowed to appear in offline examination but on the

payment of the examination fee again.

Q.21. Which Software can be used for scanning of answers during the online Exam?

Ans. Adobe Scan (Available on Play Store)

Q.22. If a student is not able to pay the examination fee, then how he/she can be permitted for

online exam.

Ans. If a student is not able to pay the examination fee, he/she can give an application to get

permission to appear in an online exam. However, their result will be declared after

payments of fees.
