It is a proud moment for DPSRU to be recognised amongst the top 3 Eminent National Institutes in the research area along with NIPER Mohali and ICT-Mumbai.

DRPI-21, a pan India competition for young researchers across academia and industry hosted by the Society for Pharmaceutical Dissolution Science (India), APTI (India) and the American Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists (AAPS Columbia, US) at an international level with eminent judges from National and International Organisations. It was conducted in 4 stages over a period of two months, including abstract submission, pre-recorded video submission, presentations and question-answer session at live events during semi-finale and finale rounds.

Over 200 abstracts were submitted in the PG category from the all over India and only 7 researchers made it to the finale.
