**Minutes of Meeting**

The NAAC review meeting was held on 05/7/2021, at 11.00 AM in VC Office, DPSRU.

The meeting was started with a welcome note by Chairman, Prof. R.K. Goyal, Hon'ble, Vice Chancellor thereafter, the agenda items were taken up for discussions.

All the criteria were discussed in detail and the respective Incharges presented their work.

In Criteria I, point wise progress of items like course objectives, course outcomes, syllabus revision (for BPT), mentor-mentee system and feedback from all stakeholders have been explained. It was advised that all the programmes like B. Pharm, M. Pharm, PhD, Physiotherapy, Management and ASSRM has been allocated a Programme code. Also, the points like student



satisfaction survey, research publications, patents of faculty members, student grievances and redressal, vision, mission, objectives of the University, strategies for fund mobilization, external and internal audits, waste management, separate classes for medium and slow learners, remedial classes, ICT facility, mentor-mentee system has been discussed.

The progress of Student Enrolment and Profile, Catering to Student Diversity, teaching learning process, Teacher Profile and Quality, Evaluation Process and Reforms, Student Performance and Learning Outcomes, Student Satisfaction Survey is also explained by respective incharge.

The progress of research innovation and extension was explained. It was suggested by Honble VC there will be research and innovation committee who will take care of several activities like coordination of research projects, research awards, matching grants, research incentives and seed grants.

The creation of research policy, IT policy of University and e-content development by the faculty members and student support for competitive exams has been discussed. It was advised that the library should be fully automated with the creation of barcoding, cloud computing and scanning facility. Software like Turnitin is also required for checking plagiarism of thesis and scientific publications.

Data for GPAT qualified students, career counseling provided to the students and funding provided by the stakeholders to the University are the points that has to be recorded as per the NAAC Proforma.


The vision, mission, short term & long term plan of the University, research mobilization, activities of IQAC cell and staff welfare measures (DGEHS, NPS, house cooperative society, Maternal leaves and group insurance) have been discussed. The PF schemes, medical claim, accidental deaths and gratuity benefits for the staff members have been included in the respected criteria (Criteria 6). Funds from Dabur research foundation, Zindal foundation, Dr. S.K. Gupta and DIFF have been included in institutional governance and management. The concepts of academic & administrative audits, institutional best practices and distinctiveness have been discussed. It was discussed and concluded that Yoga center, Outreach programmes, faculty Start-ups, MOUs with bodies of national and international repute for product development, Center of



excellence, Physiotherapy OPD and allotment of all elective subject to students can be considered as best practices or distinctiveness of the University.
